PAYMENT TERMS

- Bradford Hockey Club has adopted a policy to establish a cashless approach to the collection of membership subscriptions and all other fees where practicably possible.
- Fees have been consolidated to include: annual subscriptions, senior league and junior league match fees, training costs, pitch hire, local, county and national affiliation fees.
- Costs for local and national tournaments, invitational training sessions (JDC, JAC and JRPC etc), summer league games etc have not been consolidated and any participation may incur a small additional charge.
- Fees are to be paid or committed to on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> October in each season
- Payment is by standing order, using the form below, or as a single payment by cheque.
- Cheques should be handed to a club official, e.g. captain, team manager or club treasurer.
- Family membership discounts are available where there is more than one actively participating member. A participating member is a player, coach, club official or volunteer.
- Under club rules, if membership fees are not paid by 30<sup>th</sup> November then a player can be excluded from team selection for the rest of the season.
- It is a policy within the Yorkshire League that no player may join another club if they have debts with any other Yorkshire club.
- The club, via the Management Committee, can provide financial assistance for members encountering difficulties with payment of fees or wishing to undertake external training courses as a volunteer or club official.
- INSURANCE** – The club has some insurance cover, but members are advised to arrange their own personal accident and injury cover.
